# Mega Raffle

As of this point, all remaining tickets will be made available to the community, and you will be responsible for the \$200 payment, potentially *without* receiving tickets.

INCENTIVE: Each family that sells 5 or more tickets will earn \$50.00 in SCRIP credit. 5 families have sold 5 tickets, 3 families have sold 6 tickets, one family has sold 7 tickets, one family has sold 10 tickets and one family has sold 15 tickets!


#### Middle School Dance


