Failure to complete your pledged hours needed to reach 35 minimum by June 30, 2017 will result in an assessment for unfulfilled hours per your signed Tuition Contract. Projected hours may be added to your Service Hours Form and will be verified against the sign-in sheets provided at each event worked. Please be sure to list the date, event name, time in and out, and total number of hours worked for each event on your Service Hours Form. Always remember to sign in and out with the chairperson at each event. Service Hours forms have been provided to each family opting for Service Hours per the Tuition Contract upon registration.
