

# The Book Swap

Once a month, during lunch periods, Mrs. Wojcik and Mrs. Gasiecki will host a book swap! Students can bring gently used books from home they are finished with to "swap" for new books. We hope to encourage reading at home, without costing families any money!

## How it works:

• This will be a two day process. Day 1: students bring in their books and get a ticket for each book they turn in. Day 2: students exchange each ticket for one book.



Books <u>must</u> be grade level appropriate!

- K-1: books with pictures
- 2-5: at least one book must be a grade appropriate chapter book
- 6-8: due to a lack of participation, we cannot have these grades participate anymore  $\odot$

- Notifications of the dates each month and reminders will be posted in the newsletter.
- Grades 2+ will have to show responsibility by keeping track of their tickets. We will track grades K and 1.
- Students may "swap" up to 3 books. Books need to be "like new" condition, but not brand new. Books with torn or missing pages will not be accepted.
- We kindly ask parents <u>not</u> to come to help your children pick out books, as we want them to make their own choices (we will monitor this, of course ©).

Our first swap will start on Thursday, January 19th.

Date and anticipated time of return: 2/1/17 11:30am Method of transportation\*\*: Lancaster Busing


