



Open to all students who want to explore their creativity. Bring your photos and make fun scrapbook pages! Basic scrapbook materials are made available for your use, or bring your own to share.

Do you like to take pictures and want to show them off in a creative way? Then Scrapbook Club may be the perfect club for you! Scrapbooking is a hobby that has continued to grow in popularity. Scrapbook Club offers students an opportunity to express themselves by incorporating pictures, memorabilia, decorative paper, stickers, and die cuts into creative scrapbook pages. Students will have the opportunity to use a variety of tools and materials and will learn and practice techniques that help them showcase their pictures. No previous experience is required...all that's needed is a desire to express your individuality and a few photographs for each page you wish to create. Decorative paper, cardstock, page protectors, stickers, adhesives, markers, and an assortment of scissors (regular and decorative) will be provided. Scrapbooks are not furnished for students, but page protectors will be provided that will fit into any standard 12" by 12" post-style album (or a three ring binder for those who do not own a scrapbook).

A \$10.00 cash supply fee per student/ per session is required to cover consumable items such as paper, stickers, page protectors, and glue. Members are free to purchase additional supplies for their personal use or to share.

SERVICE HOURS SUBMISSION DEADLINE MARCH 15, 2017

The submission deadline for all Service Hours worked for the 16-17 school year is almost upon us. All parents who have agreed to work at least 35 hours per the Tuition Contract need to submit a listing of their Service Hours to Sherri Weinholtz at sherriw1175@yhahoo.com or send their completed Service Hours Form to the school Tuition Office by the March 15, 2017 deadline. Please make a copy of this form for your reference before submission. Hours may be accrued between July 1, 2016 and June 30, 2017. Failure to complete your pledged hours needed to reach 35 minimum by June 30, 2017 will result in a \$900 fee being assessed per your signed Tuition Contract. Projected hours may be added to your Service Hours Form and will be verified against the sign-in sheets provided at each event worked. Please be sure to list the date, event name, time in and out, and total number of hours worked for each event on your Service Hours Form. Always remember to sign in and out with the chairperson at each event. Service Hours opportunities are published in our weekly News Notes and through contact via Chairpersons of the various events. Service Hours forms have been provided to each family opting for Service Hours per the Tuition Contract upon registration.
