



Lancaster-Depew FCU Star Saver Program is available to all students in grades **K-6**. Students will be able to set up a savings account with the Credit Union and make weekly deposits at school. Lancaster-Depew FCU Star Saver Club Program Outline

Summary

A Youth Savings Program will be provided by the Lancaster-Depew FCU. Students will be able to set up a savings account with the Credit Union and make weekly deposits at school. Each school will have a deposit box, located at their main office, where deposits can be made once a week. There will be a "Saver's Station" where students will have the opportunity to redeem stickers they have earned from their deposits for prizes. The frequency, date, and location of this day are to be determined by each individual school. This program will be available to all elementary students in Lancaster Schools (K-3).

Deposit Days

A "deposit day" will occur once every week. The main office will house the secure lock box for deposits. Students can make a deposit into their Star Saver account by filling out a deposit slip, placing the slip and money or check (s) inside their pouch, and dropping them in the secure lock box before morning announcements begin.

A Credit Union employee will come to the school at a specified time to pick up deposits. They will log each deposit by name, and have this information verified by a designated office staff member. The credit union employee will place any stickers for that week in each student's pouch. The pouches will be placed in the corresponding teacher mailboxes to be handed back to students in class.


Reward System

Students will earn 1 sticker for every dollar saved up to a maximum of 5 stickers weekly. These stickers will be given weekly and placed in their pouches. Stickers can be placed in the Star Sticker Book provided to each student. Students can earn prizes based on the number of stickers accumulated. Prizes get better with higher amounts of stickers. Students have the option to save their stickers or turn them in right away. Any student who wishes to choose a prize from one of the tiered prize bins will turn in their sticker book and receive a new one.

Tiered prize levels are as follows:

Completed Star Sticker Books – Choose 1 Prize from our "Grand Prize" bin 30-49 Stickers – Choose from the GREEN prize bin 10-29 Stickers – Choose from the BLUE prize bin

Any student that has less than 10 stickers will be given a small prize and can keep adding to their sticker book the next month.



Open a savings account for your child with our in-school savings program! Help your child learn about money management and personal responsibility, all while making actual deposits into their new savings account.

Students will earn stickers and prizes and participate in educational and fun events centered around financial literacy and education. Help your child save for their future starting today!

WHAT IS IT?

A youth savings program, supported by the Lancaster-Depew Federal Credit Union, that introduces students at St. Mary's elementary to the benefits of saving.

HOW DOES IT WORK?

Students were introduced to the program via school mailing to their parents in December. They brought information home to their parents to get their account set up.

Once the account is set up, they can participate in our weekly deposit days that will start at the beginning of January. Students will receive a pouch for their deposits, and will drop these deposits into a lock box every week in the morning at school. This lock box will then be collected by MARY SULLIVAN. For every deposit the student makes, they earn 1 sticker. Once they accumulate 20 stickers they can turn their sticker book in for a prize!
