Service Hour Submission

The submission deadline for all Service Hours worked for the 16-17 school year is almost upon us. All parents who have agreed to work at least 35 hours per the Tuition Contract need to submit a listing of their Service Hours to Sherri Weinholtz at sherriw1175@yhahoo.com or send their completed Service Hours Form to the school Tuition Office by the March 15, 2017 deadline. Please make a copy of this form for your reference before submission. Hours may be accrued between July 1, 2016 and June 30, 2017. Failure to complete your pledged hours needed to reach 35 minimum by June 30, 2017 will result in an assessment for unfulfilled hours per your signed Tuition Contract. Projected hours may be added to your Service Hours Form and will be verified against the sign-in sheets provided at each event worked. Please be sure to list the date, event name, time in and out, and total number of hours worked for each event on your Service Hours Form. Always remember to sign in and out with the chairperson at each event. Service Hours opportunities are published in our weekly News Notes and through contact via Chairpersons of the various events. Service Hours forms have been provided to each family opting for Service Hours per the Tuition Contract upon registration.
