

Workshop 1: How to Help Your Child Learn to Read
(Thursday, October 13, 2016)

Suggestions will be given for how to help children emerge as readers and writers in preparation for the early years in school.

This workshop is for parents of children ages birth through grade 1.

See you on Thursday, 10/6! Pick-up is at 3:15 sharp. Late arrivals (after 3:20) will be directed to Fast Club.




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
