



# RULES AND PROCEDURES



## How to Enter

- Please designate one person who will be responsible for submitting entries for ALL participating teachers in your school. The coordinator may be a classroom teacher, librarian or parent volunteer.
- In order to qualify, your school must be signed up no later than January 3rd, 2017.
- Reproduce and distribute the Rules and Procedure sheet to each teacher participating in the Read to Ride program.
- Reproduce the Read to Ride student tracking chart for each student. Review the instructions on the chart trackers with your students. Please have a parent or guardian initial each chart each time the student completes a section of recreational reading. Encourage students to share the information sheet with their parents. **Remember this program is for recreational reading done between, January 1st – February 28th, 2017.**
- Teachers will be responsible for collecting and validating all student chart trackers. Please write the names and grades of the students who complete seven hours of reading and are in your classroom on the Teacher's Roster. Submit all forms to your school's designated Read to Ride Coordinator. Each participating teacher must submit a completed Teachers' Roster sheet stapled to his or her classes student tracking charts.
- Submit the completed Teacher's Roster Sheets, along with one Ticket Request Form per school, postmarked no later than March 10, 2017 to:

## Rules & Procedures

- **Students must be in grades K-5 to participate.** Only registered students of the school district are able to participate. Sorry, this program is NOT open to pre-k students.
- To become a member of the Read to Ride program, students must complete seven hours of recreational reading between, January 3rd - February 28th, 2017.
- The seven hours of reading can be in the form of reading to oneself, reading to another person or being read to by others. Students may read books, magazines or newspapers.
- To be valid, all completed Teacher's Rosters AND Ticket Requests Form must be signed by the principal and received by March 10, 2017. No late entries will be accepted.
- Please designate one person to be responsible for submitting entries for ALL participating teachers. Only one entry per school. Make sure the total number of tickets needed is marked on the Ticket Request Form.
- Return all completed forms and student tracking charts to Darien Lake.
- Each free admission ticket is valid for one admission only and is non-transferable. Tickets may not be reproduced or resold. Tickets will be valid during the months of July and August, 2017 only. Tickets are valid for both Theme Park and Water Park admission.
- Tracking charts and teacher rosters will NOT be returned. Student names will not be printed on the tickets or certificates, so please keep a copy of your records.
- Upon review of your entries, we will send you a certificate and admission ticket for each student who completed the seven-hour Read to Ride program. **Please note:** Ticket packets will start being sent to schools on April 3, 2017.
- Please verify tickets received before distributing to students. Tickets that are misplaced or destroyed can't be replaced.
