This year SME is going to participate in Darien Lake Theme Park's Read to Ride Program! This program is designed for students in grades K-5. When the students read for 7 hours, outside of the classroom, Darien Lake will treat them to a fun day at the park! The students and parents will use the attached "Student Tracking Chart" to record the time spent on leisure reading between January 13, 2017-February 28, 2017. Once the students have completed their reading challenge, SME will send the required forms back to Darien Lake and they will send a FREE park ticket to each student who has met the 7 hour goal!

These are the Rules and Procedures

- Students MUST be in grades K-5
- To become a member of the Read to Ride program, the students must meet the required 7 hours "Share-A-Book" goal
- The reading may be in the form of reading to oneself, reading to another person, or being read to by others.
- Students may read books, newspapers, or magazines
- All students tracking sheets MUST be sent back to school by March 1, 2017. No Late entries will be accepted.

The reading logs will be reviewed, which MUST be signed by a parent to verify each student's accomplishments. Once a student has reached the goal of 7 hours, they will receive one free admission ticket, for one admission only, to Darien Lake Theme Park which may only be used during the months of July and August. The tickets are valid for both Theme Park and Water Park admission.
