Dear School Family,

Planning is underway for our 23rd Annual Autumn Gold Event. This is the longest standing fundraiser for our school and parish. Each year we have been able to raise over \$17,000. The success of this fundraiser has much to do with the support of our school families. The income received for tuition does not cover the full cost of educating our children. We rely on fundraising to fill that gap and the church must subsidize where we fall short. The goal is to become and maintain a self supporting entity while keeping tuition rates affordable for our families.

This year we are planning to make some exciting changes to the event to make it a fun night out for your family and friends. There are **just 1500 tickets available** and tickets have been reduced to \$50.00 this year. Each ticket purchased enters you into a drawing to win one of 48 prizes totaling \$20,000! We have two Early Bird drawings left! Did you know that after a winning number is pulled it goes **back** into the spinner and is available for every single drawing!! One ticket admits two adults to the event which will be held on Friday, November 3rd. The doors open at 6:00 pm, and the raffles begin at 8:00 pm. Included in your ticket is a light dinner and drinks (beer/wine/pop).
