Thanks to the generosity of all of our students and families, SME came out on top last year and won this challenge!

Challenge Period 1 takes place Oct. 2nd - Dec. 14th. Our minimum goal for this period is 750 cans/boxes of food donated! This equates to 3-4 cans/boxes of food per student donated. Last fall we exceeded our goal by over 200% and we accomplished this by donating more than our minimum

Dear Parents/Guardians:

This year we welcome several students in our school (Pre K-8) with food allergies. Each year the number of students with serious allergies and strict dietary restrictions continues to grow across the country, not just here at St. Mary's. Schools are responsible for working diligently to place the children's safety and good health on the forefront each day. We ask for your help, cooperation, and understanding with the following policy.

- No unwrapped bulk, unlabeled, or home baked items may be sent into the classroom.
- Any food item that is brought into the classroom for celebrating and sharing must have the specific ingredient label on the package. All items must be peanut and tree nut free. Please be aware of advisory labels as these are also not allowed. Any items that are not packaged or properly labelled will be returned home.
- Students are not allowed to share with or purchase food items for other students during lunch or snack time. Sharing, trading, touching of other classmates' food is strictly forbidden.
- There will be a nut-free table available in the cafeteria. Please communicate with the nurse for more information if you would like your child to sit at this table.
- All students will wash their hands before and after snack time and their lunch period.

In an effort to assist parents and teachers with safe food choices, the website <u>https://snacksafely.com</u> lists numerous choices that are available in local stores-please remember this list changes often. We also suggest sending in healthy alternatives such as fruits and vegetables or consider non-food options (play doh, pencils, stickers...) or donate a book or game to the classroom in your child's name.

Thank you for your attention and support regarding this very important matter. We look forward to working together to make a healthy school year. If you should have any questions or concerns please contact the principal or school nurse.
