



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

Practices: Our first practice will be April 8 from 6-7:15. Our second practice will be April 11 from 6-7:15. After that, we will practice every Monday, Wednesday and Thursday from 6:00-7:15. All practices will be held at the Lancaster High School track unless otherwise indicated. Please make your best effort to attend as many practices as possible. We understand that students will sometimes miss practices for other commitments as elementary school is the perfect time to try out different sports and activities. There will be a brief parents meeting at the beginning of our first practice on April 8.

Meets: There will be four regular meets on weekends in May. Meets may be held on Saturday or Sunday, times TBA. (Last year we had 3 meets at noon and one at 4:00.) Meets are about 90 minutes long and we arrive 30 minutes early to warm up. There is a fifth All-SITA meet on Tuesday, June 4 at 5:30 for those who qualify. Last year, meets were held at Orchard Park HS, St. Francis HS, and Canisius HS.

Parent Volunteers: SME is required to provide six volunteers at every meet. Therefore, each track family is required to have a parent sign up to volunteer at one of the meets.
