

SCRIP

When we work together on the \$1,500.00 monthly goal, it is less than a \$200 purchase in gift cards per family, per month, through the Scrip program. Since Scrip cards can be purchased for Tops Gasoline, Tops groceries, Amazon, Tim Hortons, paying your Kohl's bill, etc I am sure we can all find easy ways to help with this goal. There is a locked box outside the Athletics office so that you can drop off orders whenever it is convenient for you! There is also one in the back of the church.

BISON FUND

Beginning January 1, 2020 parents can visit the Bison Fund website @ www.bisonfund.com to complete a scholarship pre-application for the 2020-21 school year. **The pre-application form is only for families NEW to BISON.** Current families will receive an e-mail with a link to complete the requalification process in February 2020.

The pre-application deadline is February 28, 2020. All pre-applications will be entered into a lottery drawing in early March. If families are drawn in the lottery, they will receive an e-mail with instructions on how to proceed with the application. We will also notify families that are not selected and place them on the waiting list.

Please note, the scholarship amounts vary depending on the family's income, household size, and the school's tuition cost. The maximum award will remain at \$2100 per family for the 2020-21 school year. Families will be expected to contribute partial tuition towards their child's education.

Dear Catholic School Families:

The Catholic Charities Appeal is once again asking for support to help fund the many services that it provides for our communities throughout Western New York. What you may not know is that the Appeal also helps to fund support for your Catholic schools.

- Option III-Donate to **Fund for the Faith Only**

I encourage you to please donate to Option I. Donating to both Catholic Charities and to the Fund for the Faith not only ensures that the good work of Catholic Charities continues for the neediest of our neighbors but also ensures that our Catholic schools continue to receive the support they deserve. Options II & III only serves to take from the good works of one at the expense of other.


