Summer Care runs Monday – Friday, starting Monday, June 28 – Friday, August 27, 2021

Please fill out the calendars provided for June, July and August with the days and times that you will be sending your child(ren). Payment of \$40/day per child is expected the Wednesday prior to the week that you will be sending your child(ren) to Summer Care. Invoices will be sent out the week prior. The completed calendars are due by Tuesday, June 1, 2021.

If you need to cancel a day, 2 weeks' notice must be given in order to receive a refund for that day. Each child will be allowed ONE excused sick day wherein a refund will be given for that day.


