# OUR SUCCESS DEPENDS ON YOU

As per the tuition schedule that was included in your registration paperwork:

<u>Family Service Hour & Fundraising Participation Responsibility is expected of each family.</u> Regardless of parish affiliation and tuition rate, active involvement of all SME families is necessary to keep school expenses to a minimum, encourage community involvement, and assure continued success of our school. SME hopes to promote the true spirit of participation and volunteerism which is not compensated.

Family Service Hour & Fundraising Participation Responsibility is expected of each family. 
