In an announcement by Gov. Andrew M. Cuomo yesterday, the state will adopt the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention's eased mask-wearing guidance for fully vaccinated people, which allows them to stop wearing masks outdoors in crowds and in most indoor settings.


READY SET READ

Dear Kim,
