FROM THE PRINCIPAL'S DESK...

Happy Wednesday!

The new mask removal mandates DO NOT apply to our schools. Anybody on school grounds must follow our reopening protocols which will be in place for the remainder of the school year. Also, the mandating of wearing masks all day in the classrooms is a DOH requirement. I understand that it is getting hotter and that the students would like to remove the masks. I would like nothing better than to be able to accommodate that. Unfortunately, we must follow the guidelines set forth by the DOH. If they change their mandates prior to the of the year, I will let you know.

In addition to the DOH guidance on masks, we also received guidance on graduations. The DOH Graduation guidance supersedes any other meeting space guidance for celebrations. CDC MASK GUIDELINES

In an announcement by Gov. Andrew M. Cuomo, the state will adopt the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention's eased mask-wearing guidance for fully vaccinated people, which allows them to stop wearing masks outdoors in crowds and in most indoor settings.

Nurse Notes

With the warm weather finally upon us comes more opportunities to be outside! Please remember sunscreen, hats, and proper footwear for kids while outside. We have also seen an increase of students exhibiting allergy like symptoms that can be similar to COVID symptoms. If you know your child suffers from allergies please keep up with their allergy meds to reduce symptoms and the possibility of missing school due to those symptoms. Just as a reminder, we are still requiring a doctor's note or negative COVID test if your child is absent from school due to illness.

Earlier this month was Food Allergy Awareness Week. Over 32 million Americans have a diagnosed food allergy. We have many students and faculty/staff with food allergies right here in our SME community. Being aware and knowledgeable about food allergies is very important in keeping everyone safe and included. Thank you for your continued support of sending in allergy safe snacks for class parties.

May is also Lyme disease awareness month. Lyme disease is an infectious disease caused by a bacteria which is spread by ticks. To prevent tick bites it is recommended to use bug spray with DEET, wear shoes, long pants, and long sleeve shirts while in an area where ticks are known to be. It is important that a tick is removed entirely and immediately and also saved for testing.
