Nurse Notes

Just a couple reminders for next school. All students in Pre K, K, 1, 3, 5, and 7 and any new students to our school will need an updated physical/health appraisal form completed by their doctor. All students will need to be up to date with their immunizations. Please contact your child's doctor to ensure they are. In addition to required vaccines, the United States Food and Drug Administration (FDA) recently approved a vaccine against the virus that causes COVID-19 for emergency use for children ages 12 and over. Although fewer children have been infected with COVID-19 compared to adults, children can still become infected with the virus that causes COVID-19, they can become sick, and they can spread the virus to others. Increased COVID -19 vaccination rates amongst NYS's school-aged children is critical in a continued return to normalcy in classroom settings this fall.

This school year has been anything but ordinary! Thank you for your cooperation and understanding as we navigated a school year working through a health pandemic. It has not been easy but we made it to June and definitely learned a lot along the way! Stay healthy!

The 6th through 8th graders are truly reading the music they are playing, the 4th grade accompanies themselves with Choirchimes while they sing a song in unison and in a round, and the PK classes, 2nd and 3rd grades each sing selected parts of songs but their videos combine the singing into one piece without the students ever being in the same room. The Kindergartens, 1st, and 5th grades sing songs with motions, actions, and dances.
