Thank you all for your cooperation and understanding with our new health protocols that we need to follow this school year.

We understand the frustration and want our students and staff back to school as quickly and as safely as possible.

I will always suggest a phone call to your primary doctor’s office first but would like to make you aware of a new COVID-19 testing option. The Erie County Department of Health is offering rapid COVID-19 testing for students and employees, results from the test take about 15 minutes.

The testing is at rotating locations in the northtowns, central Erie County, and southtowns. An appointment must be made to get tested; this can be done by calling 716-858-2929.

This testing is only for Erie County residents who are attending in-person classes and showing symptoms and school ID must be brought.

Payment will be due within 30 days of distribution by cash, check, charge (of 2 boxes or more) or Venmo by request.

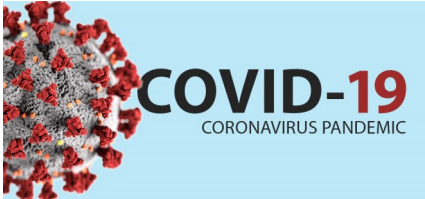

SCRIP CORNER

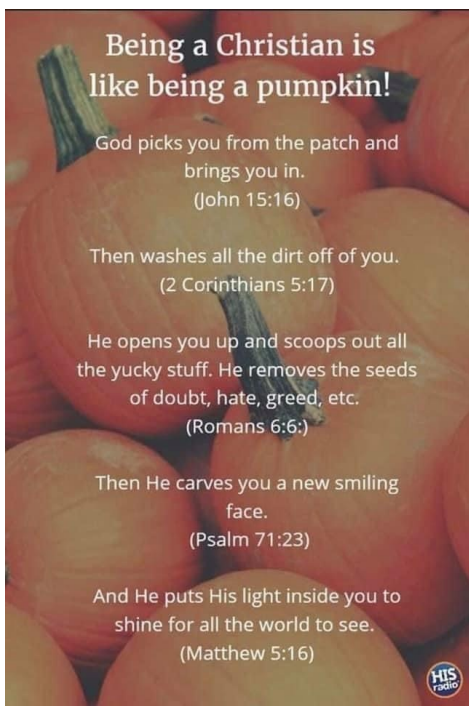

MEET THE MUSIC TEACHER

Hi, everyone!! I'm Steve Hunter and I'm extremely happy and proud to be the Music teacher here at SME. Many of the parents probably know me as the guy who holds up the morning drop off line to give treats to the dogs in the cars. This is my fourth year at SME and my 29th year teaching in Catholic schools in the Diocese of Buffalo. I got my Bachelor's and Master's degrees in Music Education from U.B. in 1992 and 2002 respectively. Over the years I've played saxophone in a number of local jazz, rock, and big bands in the area and also performed with the Amherst Chamber Ensembles, UB Saxophone Ensemble, and Erie County Wind Ensemble.

Enough about me, on to what we're going to do in school this year! Obviously we will be doing much less singing so, in the younger grades (PK - 2), we'll be doing a lot more moving and rhythm activities with recorded songs and classroom percussion instruments. Our middle grades (3-5) will do movement and rhythm activities as well, but they will also be learning more about the different styles of music, the composers, and reading music. Our middle school students are going to focus on bucket drumming and performing in Choirchime choirs. Also, our students in grades 4 - 8 have been invited to take instrument lessons at school and we should be beginning our lessons next week! One final piece about the Music Program at SME; I have been hosting a Ukulele Club after school once a week. This year, the club will be open to grades 5 - 8 and I will be having sign-up's for the Ukulele Club in a few weeks.

Share these suggestions:

- * *Knowing something about the topic or setting makes a tougher book easier to comprehend. If your youngster is reading a novel set in France, they could talk to someone who has been there or look up the country online. (try a children's site like kids.nationalgeographic.com).*
- * *Encourage your child to look at a simpler book on the same subject. A picture-book biography about Harriet Tubman may help your youngster better understand a textbook chapter on the civil rights movement, for instance.*
- * *Suggest that your child read complicated material with pencil & paper in hand. They can jot down questions, words to look up, or facts they want to learn more about.*

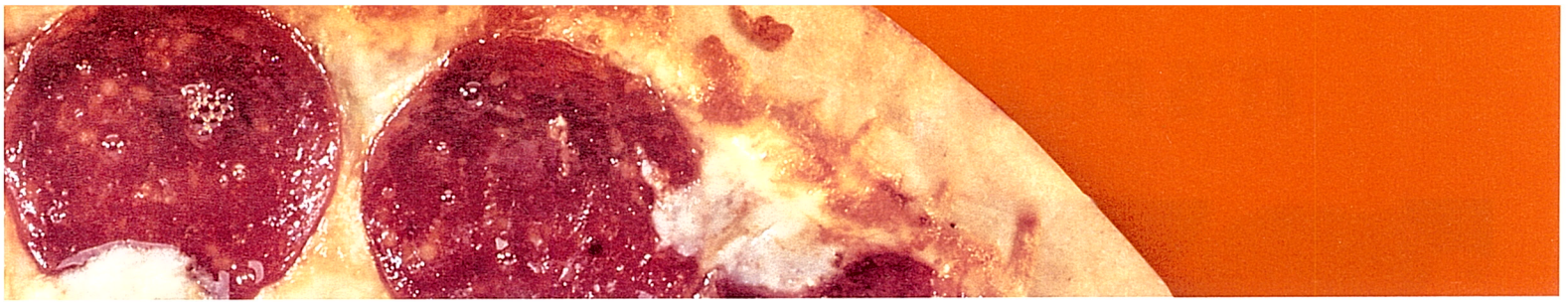

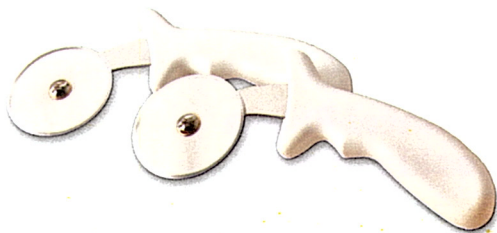

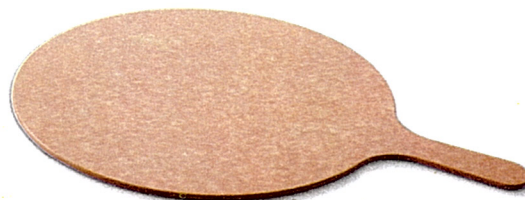
