Happy Wednesday!



SCRIP:

From 1/4/22 to 1/10/22, the Scrip rebate profit earned towards tuition was \$122.84

Nurse Notes

It is important to remind all that SME has to follow the guidelines set by the ECDOH, not the CDC.

If a student tests positive, regardless of vaccination status, a 10-day quarantine is required. Day 0 is the day of the positive test, if asymptomatic. If symptomatic, Day 0 begins the day symptoms started.

The 5-day quarantine that was put in place by NY State, is **only** in effect for essential workers at this time, not students.

We have been notified that DOH is not able to keep up with contact tracing. Please do your best at letting people know if they are considered a close contact.

At this point, per the ECDOH, <u>negative</u> at-home test results will not be accepted for early release from quarantine or for diagnostic purposes if a child is exhibiting symptoms associated with COVID-19.

<u>Positive</u> at-home COVID-19 test results are accepted by the ECDOH and should be reported. Please call the COVID-19 Information Line at (716) 858-2929 or use the online reporting form (https://www3.erie.gov/covid/form/form-to-report-a-positive-covid-).

Acceptable COVID-19 tests to shorten quarantine include rapid NAAT (PCR) or antigen tests conducted and reported by a licensed laboratory.

Please stress with your child(ren) the importance of proper mask wearing & sanitizing. This new variant mimics cold symptoms and as such we must all be vigilant in our safety precautions.

I will do my best to help all of you out, so please call with any questions. I want to continue to thank all of you for your understanding and patience.
