Dear SME Families,

Thank you for making the first 100 days of the school year exciting, productive, and memorable! Various events have brought our SME community together in celebration, recognition, and prayer. 

MEAT RAFFLE


Save the date for SME's Meat Raffle: April 29th at 7pm.


