

A Note from the Nurse

Hello SME Families,

I just want to make you all aware of an uptick in Strep throat in the community.

Thankfully we haven't seen many cases here at SME. However, I wanted to share some information with you in hopes that we can keep it at bay.

Strep Throat is a bacterial infection. It mostly affects school aged children, and is spread through close contact and by coughing and sneezing.

Signs & Symptoms:

- Fever or chills
- Red or swollen tonsils (with or without white/yellow spots on the throat)
- Painful swallowing or complaining that throat feels funny
- Tenderness in neck or swelling under jaw (swollen glands)
- Bad smelling breath
- Headache, stomach pain, vomiting

Diagnosis: is done at the pediatrician or at an urgent care type facility. Rapid results are usually ready within 15 minutes. They may send out a culture that can take up to 48 hours for results to be ready.

If your child does test positive for strep throat they may return to school after 24 hours of antibiotics.
