

#### 2023 SME Track Team

Hey boys and girls in grades 3 through 8– Come on out and join the 2023 SME track team! It's a great way to get in shape, try something new, have some fun, compete against other schools, and is a great complimentary sport to help you improve your performance in other sports. Whether you like to run short distances, long distances, jump, throw a softball, or run a relay, there are a variety of events for your participation.

Parents of boys and girls in grades 3 through 8 - We had a great team last year with 3 of the 4 coaches returning this year (the fourth moved south). Where we were short in number of kids, we made up for it with a number of outstanding individual performances. We just need more kids on the team! We haven't received final details yet for this season from the Southtowns Invitational Track Association, which runs the meets for the Catholic elementary schools. However, last year, track meets were held at St. Francis High School on a Thursday, Friday, or Saturday. We had 3 tri-meets, followed by a Divisional Championship and a League Championship meet. St. Mary's High School is kind enough again this year to let us use their school facilities for both indoor and outdoor practices. Last year, we started practicing the last week of March and the season concluded the first week of June. We will practice two nights per week, and maybe sneak in a third one occasionally. Practices will be an hour to an hour and one half long with starting times between 5 and 6pm. Firm dates and times to come later. We had 20 kids participating last year and we would really like to get that closer to 30 this year. We like to keep things fun and allow the kids to pick the events they want to participate in, as much as possible, while still competing in as many events as we can. This is a developmental program. We will be teaching proper running, jumping, and throwing mechanics. No previous experience by your children needed! Please think it over, and discuss it with your son or daughter.
