
Greetings, SME Families,

First and foremost I want to thank everyone who has taken the time to reach out in some manner regarding safe snack options and the new snack policy prior to the upcoming Halloween celebrations. I also want to take a moment to explain that this snack list is not allergen free. It only removes two major classifications of allergens; peanuts and tree nuts. There are still many more allergens contained in the snacks listed. I will continue to sort through snacks to ensure students with those allergies do not receive any of those items.

Having a pre approved snack list enables me to sort through the snacks quicker and more efficiently to ensure no student receives a snack that contains an allergen that could potentially cause them harm. So while this list may not be as "fun" as we are used to in years past, please know that this is what life is like for parents of students with severe life threatening allergies and we want to encourage celebrations that are safe for all students. That being said, any items brought in not on the list will be sent home with a note explaining such.

Student lunches are **\$3.50**, and adult lunches are **\$5.50**. During this time, we ask that all lunches be prepaid with either cash or check made out to SME, in the exact amount. Any overage will be kept on account. All lunches are comprised of five components; protein, whole grain, vegetables, fruit & milk. In addition to the main entrée, there are three alternate choices offered daily; Julienne Salad, Yogurt Parfait, or Sun Butter/Jelly Sandwich. Milk is **\$0.50**, and may be prepaid if your student buys milk regularly. **Snack will now be served to all grades during lunchtime**. No snack is ever purchased on account.
