Vision & Hearing Screens

Vision & Hearing screenings will begin in October. Students in Kindergarten, 1st, 3rd, 5th & 7th grades will have their vision and hearing checked. As will any student who is new to SME. If you would like your child's vision or hearing checked please reach out and I will happily add them to the list. Referrals will be sent home as needed.

Physicals

New York State requires all students in grades K,1,3,5,7 as well as any new student or students wishing to participate in sports to have a current physical for the 2023 school year.

Physicals are also required for students to participate in PE, please send in your students physical ASAP if you have not done so already.

I will continue to reach out if one is still needed for your student.

Illnesses

Please view the accompanying handout "I need to stay Home If...". This handout will provide you with the guidelines necessary to help prevent the spread of illnesses. Also, please note that any student who tests positive for Covid must isolate for 5 days and can return on day 6 with the recommendation they wear a mask days 6-10.

We can minimize illness by: 1-Getting plenty of rest 2- Eating a balanced diet 3- Drinking more water 4- Avoiding crowded areas 5- Covering coughs/sneezes 6- Washing hands frequently or using sanitizer

Dear Parents/Guardians:

Every year the number of students with severe, life threatening food allergies and strict dietary restrictions continues to grow across the country. Each year we welcome multiple students into our school (PreK-8) with multiple food allergies and sensitivities. Schools are responsible for working diligently to place the children's safety and good health on the forefront and we ask for your cooperation, and understanding with the following policy:

- No unwrapped bulk, unlabeled, or home baked items may be sent into the classrooms.
- All food items brought into the classroom for celebrating and sharing must be from the accompanying pre-approved snack list.
- All treats must be dropped off in the Main Office prior to the classroom celebration, no exceptions.
- Any treats that are included in a party favor type bag MUST HAVE the original bag used to make such party favors included with them at drop off, no exceptions.
- Students are not allowed to share with or purchase food items for other students during lunch or snack time. Sharing, touching, or trading of food is strictly prohibited.
- **Treats/snacks brought in for celebrations that are not on the pre-approved list will be sent home. **

In an effort to assist parents/guardians and teachers please see the accompanying pre-approved snack list. We realize that there are not many items on the list, however, this is what life looks like for those who suffer with life threatening food allergies. Also, items that were once safe can quickly become unsafe and we will update the list as needed throughout the year.

Thank you for your attention and support regarding this very important matter. We look forward to working together to make this a healthy and safe school year for every student at St. Mary's. If you should have any questions or concerns please contact the principal or the school nurse.

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



ENTRANCE EXAM PREP COURSE for prospective students in grades 7 & 8 Saturdays from 8:30 am to noon, October 21-November 11

The St. Joe's Entrance Exam Prep Course is specifically designed to fit the individual study needs of boys in both 7th and 8th grade. The 8th grade class emphasizes test taking strategies, including timed practice.

The 7th grade curriculum will focus less on test-taking and more on developing the underlying skills that help better prepare students for academic success: reasoning skills, math problem solving, vocabulary, and reading comprehension.
