On Friday, November 17th we invite our Grandparents to join us for a special Mass.



Collection Dates: Mon. 11/13 - Thurs. 11/16 - Your item(s) may be brought in on any day for collection.

Collection Items/Suggested Classes:

-<u>Pre-K - Condiments/Spices:</u> mustard, ketchup, mayo, Miracle Whip, salad dressings, chili sauce, bbq sauce, salt, pepper, parsley flakes, oregano, etc.

-<u>Grades K-5 - Canned/Pre-Packaged Fruits:</u> applesauce, peaches, pears, pineapples, cranberry sauce, oranges, mandarins, single serve fruit packs/cups

-<u>Grades 6-8 - Canned Proteins</u>: tuna, chicken, canned meals like stew, chili, any kind of Chef-Boyardee typed meal, beans (black, kidney, baked, etc.)






