Dear SME Families,

Collection Items/Suggested Classes:

-<u>Pre-K - Condiments/Spices:</u> mustard, ketchup, mayo, Miracle Whip, salad dressings, chili sauce, bbq sauce, salt, pepper, parsley flakes, oregano, etc.

-<u>Grades K-5 - Canned/Pre-Packaged Fruits:</u> applesauce, peaches, pears, pineapples, cranberry sauce, oranges, mandarins, single serve fruit packs/cups
