Dear SME Parents,

I wanted to communicate an update on St. Mary's Elementary School's Middle States accreditation process. The Middle States Association is an outside agency that will serve as an independent voice that will assist in SME's self-study and goal of self-improvement. Throughout this process, our School Improvement Team (SIT) will establish and reach our goals, develop a strategic plan, and promote staff development, and advance student achievement.

The earliest stages of this plan involve Middle States surveys of various groups of stakeholders, including students, teachers, members of our school board, and parents. Our School Improvement Team will review the responses and produce a summary of the collected data. These summaries will be used to form our school goals and, ultimately, our strategic plan. As of this week, our SIT has completed working with the student surveys and will be transitioning to working with the adult surveys and the adult stakeholders.
