The Middle States Association is an outside agency that will serve as an independent voice that will assist in SME's self-study and goal of self-improvement. Throughout this process, our School Improvement Team (SIT) will establish and reach our goals, develop a strategic plan, and promote staff development, and advance student achievement.

The earliest stages of this plan involve Middle States surveys of various groups of stakeholders, including students, teachers, members of our school board, and parents.
