

## St. Mary's Elementary School Uniform Policy 2024-2025

All uniforms are to be neat, clean and properly fitting. Shirts are to be tucked in at all times.

GIRLS	
Do's	Don'ts
K-5: Uniform plaid knee-length jumper, khaki or navy blue skirt/skort, pants.	K-8: No skirt/skort/shorts more than 2" above the knee. No cargo pants.
6-8: Uniform plaid, navy, khaki skirt or skort. Khaki or navy pants & belt	K-8: No nail polish or makeup
	<b>Warm Weather:</b>
K-8: White, red, navy blue polo shirt or turtleneck. White collared shirts with a school plaid or navy blue tie are also acceptable.	September, October, May, June: K-8: Navy blue or khaki knee length shorts may be worn with a belt.
K-8: Shirts must be tucked in at all times.	
K-8: Socks must be worn every day	

BOYS	
Do's	Don'ts
K-8: Navy blue or khaki dress pants.	K-8: No cargo pants
K-8: A belt must be worn with pants & shorts.	K-8: No nail polish or makeup
	<b>Warm Weather:</b>
K-8: White, red, navy blue polo shirt or turtleneck. White collared shirts with a tie are also acceptable.	September, October, May, June: K-8: Navy blue or khaki knee length shorts may be worn with a belt.
K-8: Shirts must be tucked in at all times.	
K-8: Socks must be worn every day	

**\*\* Parents & Students are required to complete & return page 2 only \*\***

<b>Shoes</b>	Casual dress shoe of neutral color (black, white, tan, brown, grey, navy). i.e.: Flats with rubber soles, boat shoes, dress shoes.
	No sneakers are to be worn during the school day (unless in grades K-3 on PE days)
	Socks should be worn every day
	<b>NO: toeless, backless, crocs, sandals, heels above 1". All shoes must fit securely. No boots/UGGS are allowed during the school day.</b>

<b>PE Class / Uniform</b>	K-8 Uniform: Uniform t-shirt, shorts, socks and sneakers. Uniform sweatshirt and sweatpants may be worn if desired.
	K-3: Students will wear their PE uniform on scheduled PE days.
	4-8: Students will bring their PE uniform and change prior to class
	<i>SME Online Store will be open prior to the start of the school year and again in the spring.</i>

<b>Hair</b>	All hairstyles should be neat with bangs above the eyebrows.
	Boys hair should be above (not touching) the shirt collar.
	No extreme hairstyles: extensions of any type, bleached, dyed or streaks, shaved in designs.
	Hats may be worn on dress down or theme attire days.
	No extreme hair accessories.

<b>Cold Weather Items</b>	SME outer wear may be worn as uniform tops when the weather dictates (It is cool or cold outside). Examples of such outer wear are: SME spirit hoodie (available through the SME Online Store), the SME gym uniform sweatshirt (available through the SME Online Store), a solid navy/white/red cardigan sweater, a navy-blue fleece from a school approved vendor (McKay's, Flynn O'Hara, Lands End), or any other SME shirt not listed here.
	Girls: Solid black leggings may be worn under skorts/skirts in the winter months.

<b>Jewelry</b>	Boys & Girls: simple necklaces are permitted
	Girls may wear simple post earrings.
	Boys are not permitted to wear earrings.
	Face piercings, including nose rings, are not permitted.

<b>Perfume / Cologne</b>	Fragrances (body spray/perfume/cologne/spray deodorant) may be used in moderation, keeping in mind that they may cause problems for those with allergies &/or breathing difficulties.

### Non-Uniform Days

<b>Dress Up Days</b>	Students are able to wear nice clothes to school. All skirts, skorts & dresses are to be knee-length. Strapless/spaghetti strap dresses/tops are not allowed. Dress shoes with less than a 1" heel are allowed. No strappy shoes or flip flops are allowed. No jeans, sweatpants etc. are allowed on Dress Up days.
<b>Dress Down Days</b>	Students are able to wear casual clothes which are modest, tasteful and appropriate to school. Jeans may be worn provided they are free of holes, tears, frays etc. Shorts & skirts must be no shorter than our uniform requirements. No pants are permitted with words across the rear. No strappy shoes, flip flops or slippers. Students may wear UGGS & dress boots.

Students may wear boots to school and change into uniform approved footwear during the winter months.

ALL UNIFORM RULES & GUIDELINES ARE SUBJECT TO THE DISCRETION OF THE PRINCIPAL.

Parents & Students are required to complete and return page 2 acknowledging the receipt and understanding of the uniform policy.
