FROM THE PRINCIPAL'S DESK...

Dear Parents,

Allow me to again welcome you back to St. Mary's Elementary School!

Because of our phenomenal staff and the close partnership we have with our dedicated group of parents, our school continues to flourish, as we expand and evolve our curricula and extracurricular offerings. Thank you all for helping to make St. Mary's such a special place - and so much more than just a school.

Our school has grown with our enrollment, which has resulted in some minor changes to some procedures. Specifically, our pre-K dropoff is slightly different than it has been in the past. The newly renovated lot on Aurora St. has arrows alerting parents where to enter and exit. Parents and guardians of our PK3 students - thank you so much for your continued patience and cooperation, as we work together to ensure the safety of all of our students. Pre-K4 parents dropping off and pickup up along the side of the building on St. Joseph St.: please do not block the driveway. This lane must be clear, as it is used by our buses, which need to stay on a very regimented schedule. And finally, for our afternoon private pick-up drivers: we have been able to begin dismissal around 2:22-2:25, about the same time we did last year.

Finally, in order to meet enrollment demands and so that we may position each and every one of our students in an optimal position for success, we have made some renovations and alterations to our building. I am so excited to share these and so much more about our new Pillars of Saint Mary's program with you at our Meet the Teacher Night, which is tomorrow, September 19, from 5:30 - 7:30. As a reminder, this is an opportunity for you and your child(ren) to come into the school, introduce yourselves to the teachers, and take a look around. This is not a conference night; Parent-Teacher Conference night is November 8.

Step 1: VISIT CAMPUS

Our community is happy to provide opportunities for prospective students and their families to visit campus this fall and to select an option that works best for their family. Step 2: APPLICATION FOR ADMISSION

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To be considered for admission, prospective freshmen for fall 2025 must do the following:
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- 1. Complete an online Application for Admission
- 2. Sit for the Entrance & Scholarship Exam on Saturday, November 23, 2024, at 8:30 a.m. A completed Application for Admission serves as registration for the Entrance & Scholarship Exam.
- 3. Provide the Admissions Office copies of final academic transcripts, or reports cards, from grades 6 and 7, along with the first 8th grade report.
- 4. Schedule an Applicant Family Interview by contacting the Admissions Office at 716.874.4953. The interview is optional but provides an excellent opportunity for the Admissions Committee to determine how St. Joe's can best serve a student.

Step 3: ENTRANCE EXAM PREP COURSE

Let the faculty of the premier college preparatory school in Western New York prepare you for the Catholic High School Scholarship & Entrance Exam. Open to boys in grades 7 & 8, our tried-and-true methods will have you feeling your best come exam day.

Registration is open at <u>St. Joe's Entrance Exam Prep Course</u>

Four consecutive Saturday mornings October 26 – November 16

Step 4: SCHOLARSHIP AND ENTRANCE EXAM

Prospective members of the Class of 2028 must take the Scholarship and Entrance Exam held on *Saturday, November 23 at 8:30 a.m.* at St. Joe's.

Step 5: ADMISSION DECISION NOTIFICATION

Notification of acceptance & merit-based awards will be mailed to students on **January 23**, **2025**. Notification of any need-based awards, along with instructions concerning enrollment, will be mailed to parents also on 1/23/25.

Step 6: ENROLLMENT

To enroll an accepted student in the St. Joe's Class of 2029 parents will complete our online enrollment process, select a payment plan, electronically agree to our tuition contract and pay the \$525 deposit via credit card. Specific instructions will be shared with parents upon acceptance.
