FROM THE PRINCIPAL'S DESK...

Dear SME Families,

Thanks to all who attended last week's Meet the Teacher Night. The construction in the gym that forced us to relocate to the parish center has been completed. We have a brand new ceiling and the lights have been installed! The gym is again usable for physical education classes, and will be complete after the speakers are installed.

Because we were in close quarters, it was difficult to hear, and things may have been rushed, I wanted to share in print an abridged version of my annual welcome message. Please see the message below:

Welcome to our annual Meet the Teacher Night!

If you are returning to St. Mary's, please notice the upgrades and improvements we have made to the building since last year. We have renovated room 107 and room 100, to increase learning space to meet the needs of our growing enrollment. Our library has been moved to room 109.

We have also continued to take steps to communicate the identity of our school with everyone, students, our teachers and staff, parents, and guests. Everyone who walks through our halls will know that we strive to increase the **so-cial responsibility** of our students, help guide them in their **spiritual growth**, and enable all students to work towards their potential, their **academic excellence**.

Whether this is your first year here at SME or you have been here for a decade, as you walk through the school, please notice the reminders of our mission statement and the shields associated with each wing of our building.

We will continue to see these shields and learn of their significance. This year, we will continue to grow our spin on the house system. In what we have coined the Pillars of SME, all students will be assigned one of our pillars and colors. Over the year, we will have friendly competitions - SME games - and keep score, to see how our pillars are doing. Whichever house accumulates the most amount of points will be awarded the SME Cup and a special reward for their victory! All students from the Steller Blue Team, which represents academic excellence, enjoys a dress down day every Monday for the rest of 2024.

Some of the goals of this idea are

1) **Create opportunities for the students to have fun**. Students enjoy themselves and each other's company at St. Mary's. School can be serious. We certainly take our responsibilities and our service as educators very seriously, but it also must be fun. Our pillars are a way for all of us to enjoy the relationships we are intentionally building - as we also celebrate each other.

2) **Build community.** A third of our students will be on team red, white, and blue. The kiddos in grades 7 and 8 on the red team will be rooting for the kiddos on the red team in Kindergarten and grade 3. It is my hope that our entire building continues to grow closer together as a result of these purposeful steps we're taking to build camarade-rie.

3) **Leadership**. Our teachers will also be competing and on a team. They'll be working with student leaders on various projects over the year. This will allow all of us to see different sides of each other - and it will also allow aspects of each individual to shine through. Not everyone is an honor student or an athlete or an artist. This system is a way for students to get involved and be proud of their school, as they can also work to make it an even better place to be.

This year, we will be selling our new pillar t-shirts. Please contact HSA if you are not sure which color team your son or daughter is on. You can order the shirt through the QR codes.

As information is shared about the Pillars, please feel free to email me with questions - or offers to get involved in the school and help to do your part. This is such an exciting time for St. Mary's - we're truly a special place ... and so much more than just a school.




